.02 Message Storage and Forward. This service provides the customer with a message relay service. The customer will contact a Teleconnect attendant by entering a "*4" following the tone, tape the desired message, and specify the date and time for delivery. Teleconnect will attempt to deliver the message in the following manner. The initial attempt will correspond with the customer's requested time of delivery, the next three (3) attempts will be spaced fifteen (15) minutes apart, and the last four (4) attempts will be spaced sixty (60) minutes apart. Teleconnect will make no more than eight (8) attempts at delivery. Teleconnect does not guarantee successful delivery of messages.
